rebuffed when He was among us? "Is a servant greater than His master?" (John 15:20)



Greetings from ZOE for Life!

Livonia, Michigan

In our efforts to expand the outreach of our ministry, ZOE for Life has partnered with Image Clear Ultrasound Detroit ... a mobile ultrasound-equipped vehicle that provides free pregnancy tests, basic ultrasounds and referrals to social agencies for women in crisis pregnancies. We gave the ICU Mobile vehicle staff a supply of our ZOE for Life! brochures and asked them to refer any pregnant women to us who are in need of diapers, wipes, maternity and baby clothing or layette items.

We received our first referral from ICU Mobile on August 2. This young woman is truly in a crisis situation. She is 23 years of age, has 4 children (ages 1, 2, 5 and 7) and is pregnant with her 5th child.

She was very depressed, her car had broken down and she couldn't afford to repair it. At the time we called her, she only had 5 diapers left for her 2 youngest children. The very next day, 2 women from our ZOE ministry delivered 300 diapers to this mother's home, as well as household items that she desperately said she needed (laundry soap, paper towels, toilet paper, Kleenex, canned goods). We promised her that we would provide clothing for all of her children and we have learned that she is going to carry her unborn child to term. We are so very humbled that she has chosen life for her baby and will continue to help her however we are able to.

Our Michigan ZOE ministry can be very difficult... these mothers are in very dire financial straits and their needs are far beyond what we can provide. One of the moms with 2 young daughters is homeless and another recently had her 3 children removed from their home due to opioid abuse by the mother. We do not stand in judgment, as these beautiful children did not choose to

be born into such poverty or unstable living conditions. We pray that God will guide us as we do whatever we can to provide material and emotional support to these women, who often feel that their lives are so hopeless.

We are so very grateful for the generous donations of infant clothing, diapers/wipes and layette items from the Orthodox community in Detroit. By the grace of God we were able to provide each of our 4 pregnant moms with a stroller, car seat and Pack 'n Play upon the birth of

their babies. Even a donated double stroller for the mom who had twins!

Additionally, we recently learned about a Community Diaper Program offered by Jet.com for non-profit organizations. We applied and are now approved to purchase diapers online at a 30% discount, with no shipping charges or tax. What a blessing!
