Preparing to Serve

ZOE for Life!® affirms the value of life by providing nonjudgemental, confidential support during and after an unplanned pregnancy. We believe, as the Orthodox Church teaches, that every life is sacred and unrepeatable, in the image and likeness of our Creator. Whatever legal and societal opinions are, with His Guidance, we work to change the hearts and minds of those around us, to cherish the lives of the unborn child, as well as those of their parents. Each must be cared for and nurtured, so that no one feels forced to choose between their future, and the life of their their child.

While some pregnancies are unviable and will end in a spontaneous abortion, and some of our sisters in Christ will be faced with the potential to lose their own life if the pregnancy continues, we direct our efforts to love, support and inform those who find themselves in a situation of distress due to an unplanned pregnancy.

Many support systems exist to lift her beyond what she can currently see. We want to offer her the opportunity to complete her education; to gain assistance outside of her present situation; to obtain free medical assistance during her pregnancy and for her child up to 18 years of age; 'holding time', where a qualified family will care for her child until her life is more stable. There are myriad opportunities to lift her up, to prove to her that she is not alone. Upon the opening of our women's center, these are a few of the things we will be able to share with her.

For those who have chosen abortion in the past, and seek to heal that wound, an abortion recovery program will be available, as it is today.

In January alone, even though the women's center has not opened yet, we worked with a couple who had made an appointment for an abortion, but through loving guidance chose to marry instead, and parent their child; with a woman traumatized by a miscarriage seeking guidance and the forgiveness of God, to be able to move forward in her life; with a new mother needing a temporary respite from motherhood, to get her life in order, and a young married Orthodox couple seeking information about creating an adoption plan for their baby, because they were uncertain they are ready to parent their child. If this work is being done before we even open our doors, just imagine what we can accomplish once our women's center is established. Surely, this is an indication that He wants this ministry to flourish.

We know that the opposite of love is not hate - it is indifference. The time has come to choose love, His Love is the All Powerful and Unsurmountable Victor over the darkness that works to deprive our children of their birthright. Please join us in creating the oasis of peace that women in distress need, in order to hear and evaluate information that will empower them to make the best possible decision. Blessing of ZOE for Life!® Southern Tier Office and Baby Shower

ZOE for Life! Southern Tier took a big step recently toward fulfilling its mission to help pregnant women who need confidential emotional and spiritual support to encourage them to choose life for their unborn child, and to provide baby items and referrals to life-affirming resources.

On Saturday, November 12, 2022, supporters of ZOE for Life!® Southern Tier gathered at Dormition of the Virgin Mary Church in Binghamton, NY, for its first baby shower and blessing of its new office space. The afternoon events began in the Church with His Eminence, Archbishop Michael (Diocese of New York and New Jersey, OCA) presiding over the "Prayer Service before

Beginning Any Good Work." Prayers were included for those working to support life, those struggling with pregnancy challenges, and those impacted by abortion.

The clergy and faithful (representing several Orthodox jurisdictions) then proceeded next door for the blessing of the "ZOE House," " the office space for ZOE for Life!® Southern Tier, which is located in the parish's hall. Participants were able to venerate the sacred relics of the Holy Inno-

cents—children massacred by Herod after the birth of Christ—which were brought there for the special blessing of the ZOE for Life!® facility.

They then returned to the Dormition Church undercroft for refreshments and remarks by Paula Kappos, a founder of ZOE for Life!, and others. Paula, along with Helen and George Primbas, had graciously traveled from the ZOE for Life!® national

office in Cleveland to share in this momentous event. Paula delivered an impassioned review of the history of ZOE for Life! in Cleveland, shared some touching stories of women whom they had been able to help, and emphasized that not only are blessings delivered to their clients, but volunteers also experience fulfillment in sharing the love of Christ with those in

The event provided the opportunity to network with

Thanks to everyone who helped make the event a huge success! It was overwhelming to see not only

the outpouring of material support—carloads of baby items as well as financial donations—but the palpable supportive spirit that infused the prayer service, blessing, and baby shower.
